16.45 Departure to Kintulammi hiking and conservation area close to Tampere city.

Kintulammi is a great hiking area and nature reserve in the Teisko-Aitolahti region of Tampere. It is a public nature and hiking destination with trails, duckboards, lean-tos and signposts. The area is located approximately 20 kilometers outside Tampere city center in the direction of Teisko.

17.30 Arrival to Kintulammi and short walk to Kortejärvi Farm: Dinner, sauna, possibility to make "short or a bit longer hike".

The old Kortejärvi farm is located in the middle of Kintulammi area. The farm came to the City's ownership in the 1990s. The farm buildings were respectfully restored in the spirit of olden times, and the charming yard environment and sauna with a woodburning stove are available to rent.

Ex-director general of Natural Resources Center, Ph.D. **Hannu Raitio** tells about Geopark Lauhanvuori-Hämeenkangas.


